Open Threads, formerly known as Esperanza Threads, welcomes refugees and formerly incarcerated individuals and provides them with the sewing and fashion skills needed to maintain a decent living. Open Threads helps our sisters and brothers feel comfortable and welcome in our neighborhoods.

Welcome. That was the spirit with which we Ursulines, at our Annual Assembly, welcomed six partners in ministry to review our community's potential future and to offer us their assessment, encouragement, and suggestions. Aware of our ever-decreasing numbers and ever-increasing median age, we decided to take a bold look at our possible future. These six individuals provided that view.

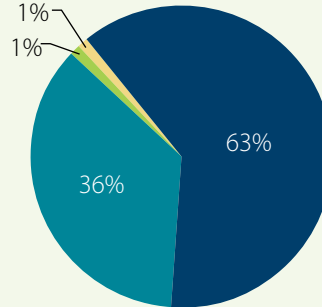

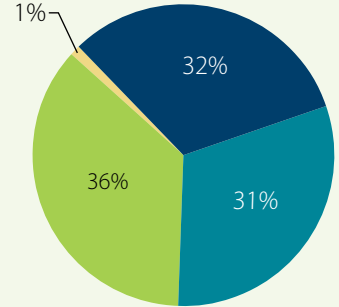

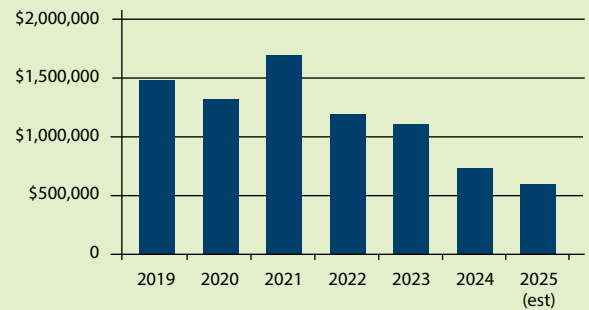
Operating Revenues

Revenue from Sisters' Salaries

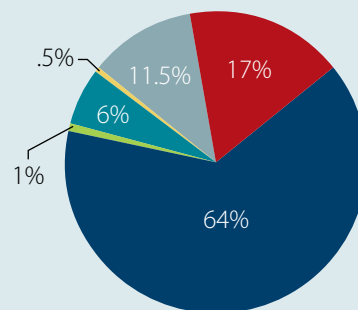

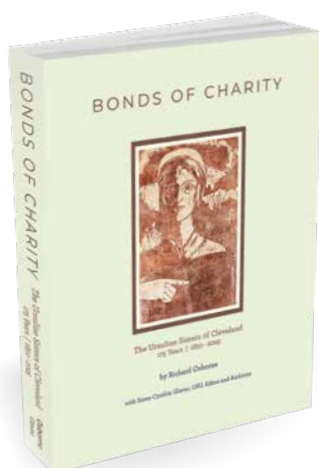
175 Years of the Ursuline Sisters of Cleveland



Loganberry hosted the *Bonds of Charity* book launch on November 9, 2025

Bibliophiles from the east and west sides of Cleveland gathered at Loganberry Books in Larchmere on Sunday, November 9 to celebrate the launch of *Bonds of Charity: 175 Years of the Ursuline Sisters of Cleveland*. This new book, co-authored by Cleveland's own Richard Osborne and Sister Cynthia Glavac, OSU, the congregation's archivist, chronicles the history of the Ursuline congregation in Northeast Ohio while envisioning the Sisters' next chapters.

CELEBRATING 175 YEARS OF URSULINE LEGACY: A REFLECTION ON SERVICE, FAITH, AND THE FUTURE

Before the panel began, the sisters watched a video of a recent prayer service at Calvary Cemetery — a moving ceremony honoring the sisters who have gone before them.

In a spirit of deep gratitude and hope, the Ursuline Sisters recently gathered for a special assembly to mark the 175th anniversary of their congregation. In celebration of this historic milestone, the Sisters welcomed long-time friends, collaborators, and those impacted by their ministry to share personal stories and reflections on the profound influence the Ursuline community has had over the years.

The assembly was both a tribute to the past and a call to courageously step into the future. Each guest speaker brought a unique perspective, highlighting the enduring legacy of the Ursuline mission and offering challenges for the journey ahead.

The first speaker, Peggy Connell, a former teacher, guidance counselor, and principal at Beaumont School, shared heartfelt memories of her more than 50 years of connection with the Ursulines. Her journey began when Sister Rosemary Hocesvar hired her to teach history at Villa Angela Academy—her first

encounter with the story and spirit of St. Angela Merici. “While at Villa Angela, I learned how to take risks,” Peggy reflected. She spoke about how those early experiences shaped her life and leadership, and she called the Sisters to action with a resonant challenge: “The Ursulines have always met the needs of the time. Our challenge today is to be able to say ‘yes’ to the future.”

Following Peggy, her husband, Jim Connell, a former professor at Ursuline College, echoed the theme of purposeful connection. He urged the Sisters to “reach out to our connections, past and present,” emphasizing that “there is still more work to be done.” His words underscored the importance of partnership and community in continuing the Ursuline mission.

The third speaker, Dorothy Valerian, a proud graduate of both Beaumont School and Ursuline College, offered a moving testimony about the Ursulines’ role in shaping not only her education but also her spiritual life. She fondly recalled learning from Sister Lucina at Our Lady of Peace, who instructed her to write “SDG” (Soli Deo Gloria) at the top of her school papers—a practice that stayed with her through college, where Sister Michael Francis reminded her of its powerful meaning: For the Glory of God Alone. With gratitude and conviction, Dorothy encouraged the Sisters: “Celebrate the light you have brought.”

Her daughter, Lisa Valerian Yahey, also a Beaumont alumna, spoke next. Lisa shared how she has been inspired throughout her life by the words of St. Angela Merici: “Act, persevere, believe, strive, hope, cry to God with all your

heart—then undoubtedly you will see wonderful things.” Lisa described these words as a guiding light, offering strength and motivation in times of uncertainty.

The final speaker, Dorothy Russo Moulthrop, also a Beaumont alumna and the current President of the Beaumont School Board of Trustees, delivered a stirring message of resilience and hope. “Continue to show the world a reason to hope,” she urged. “Be a bright light—and don’t give up.” Her words were both a celebration of the Ursulines’ enduring commitment and a challenge to carry that light forward.

The program was skillfully facilitated by Dan Moulthrop, CEO of the Cleveland City Club and husband of Dorothy Russo Moulthrop. His thoughtful guidance helped weave the stories together, emphasizing the shared values and vision of the Ursuline community and its extended family.

As the Sisters reflected on these moving testimonies, it was clear that the 175th anniversary is not just a celebration of the past—it is a recommitment to the values of faith, service, education, and courage that have defined the Ursuline legacy for generations. With hearts full of gratitude and eyes fixed on the future, the Ursuline Sisters continue to embody their mission: to serve, to teach, to inspire, and to bring the light of Christ into the world.

URSULINE SISTERS PROVIDE A WARM WELCOME TO THEIR NEW NEIGHBORS

We all like to feel welcome when we move into a new situation and become a new neighbor. This was true for the Ursulines who came from France to Cleveland in 1850 and is just as true today for our new neighbors at Creative Living for Life at the Ursuline Sisters. This community of adults with disabilities offers a place for them to live independently in their own space. As each new resident has moved in during September and October, the Ursuline Sisters welcomed them with joy and hospitality.

One by one the homes are being filled. After our new neighbors have moved and settled in, a group of Ursuline Sisters representing the congregation meets them and offers a basket of “Welcome to the neighborhood” goodies, prepared by the sisters themselves and gathered from local merchants and Ursuline College.

Amy, George, and Mya warmly invited a group of sisters into their homes when the sisters brought their basket and warm wishes to their doors. Amy looked through the basket as she inspected each item and offered a warm “Thank you” to the sisters.

The baskets include items made by the sisters themselves, such as scarves crocheted by Sister Joan Marie Russ, potholders made by Sister Martha Mooney, and a lovely, framed photo of a sunrise over Ursuline made by Sister Charlotte Trenkamp. Other items include pens, glue sticks, flashlights, notecards, a pass for a sports event from Ursuline College, a meal ticket from the Metz Culinary services at the Pilla Student Center, and coupons for bakery goods from Casa Dolce on Mayfield Road.

Some residents attend Sunday Mass with the sisters in the Merici Crossings chapel. George’s enthusiasm about being able to participate in Eucharist and pray with the sisters is contagious. Sister Barbara Jean Sever told him, “George, we pray so much better when you are here.” George’s response: “I hope so!”

When asked what she likes most about moving into Creative Living for Life, Mya, who works at Kinder Care, responded, “Meeting the other people who live here. That is the best thing.”

The sisters who have personally welcomed each resident have found that they, too, have received gifts in return—of the intangible variety. Sister Rose Marie Carfagna is grateful for “the honor to be invited into their homes.” Sister Diana Stano notes that “They have waited a long time for this.” Medina Creative Housing owns and operates the project, which has taken 13 years to come to fulfillment. Residents move one by one into each home after it is officially licensed for occupancy.

The next phase of the project includes construction of a community center as a place for community activities as well as a welcome center for new residents.

Every person has the support of a caregiver as well as family members in adjusting to the new surroundings and living comfortably in the homes. Each housing unit has its own kitchen, living room, laundry room, one or two bedrooms, and a small outdoor patio where people can enjoy the beautiful surroundings of the nearby woods and college campus.

One sister expressed her delight at seeing the new neighbors finally moving in. “This is wonderful! It is so good to see people on campus who will enjoy the beauty of our property as well as the sisters’ warm welcome and exciting events that Ursuline College can provide. This is a blessing for us all!”

COLORFUL THREADS OF LOVE

When I entered the door to Open Threads I walked into a space alive with women chatting with one another as they were sewing an individual garment or tote bag. The atmosphere was one of respect and camaraderie. Class was just about to end; a few minutes later they started to pack up their things and left on a happy note.

This small organization with a spacious mission is celebrating its 25th anniversary this year. Founded in 2000 by Sr. Mary Eileen Boyle, inspired by the Grassroots Coalition for Environmental and Economic Justice, it became separately incorporated in 2002.

"Esperanza Threads" has come full circle from its original purpose of training people in industrial sewing so they could find employment. As Sr. Mary Eileen explains, "While outside forces have reshaped the ministry itself, the mission has not changed. Maintaining the core values of justice and compassion is critical to the success of Open Threads." St. Angela Merici, foundress of the Ursuline Sisters, encouraged

her sisters to see each individual they served as "engraved in their heart."

On its website it states that Open Threads "trains and empowers Cleveland community members in the sewing trade. This grows avenues of economic opportunity while offering a space to learn, connect, and improve sustainability within the local textile industry." Symbolic of its mission, it was first named "Esperanza" Threads, offering hope to those in need. Co-workers and volunteers have been essential from the beginning. Recently its name was changed to "Open" Threads to describe itself as an organization that is open and welcoming to all, especially in the city of Cleveland. In 2011 it relocated to 1370 W. 69th Street, Cleveland 44102.

Although Sr. Mary Eileen retired last year, it is clear that her dedication and commitment to the people served by Open Threads has not wavered. She now volunteers there one day a week with as much enthusiasm as ever. More importantly,

she is a cheerleader and mentor to the Interim Director, Kerem Gençer.

Clearly, serendipity, or more accurately, Divine Providence, was responsible for introducing him to Open Threads. Having recently moved to the neighborhood in the spring of 2023, he was walking up and down the streets to get acquainted with the area when he was attracted by a sign on the door of Open Threads. The sign asked for donations of fabric; it was clear to him that this was a space that believed in practicing sustainability. Sr. Mary Eileen welcomed him in and he's never left! After first volunteering, then serving part-time in grant communications, he was a natural when an Interim Director was needed.

With a background in engineering and sustainable development, his enthusiasm for the mission is palpable. The son of an immigrant, he has a deep respect for those aiming to make a living after relocating to the U.S. His commitment to ecological responsibility is also a driving force in his life.

Now at the helm, Kerem has set a goal to obtain certification for the organization to be able to offer an Ohio Department of Labor Certified Apprenticeship program. This would serve to attract more clients and make it possible to secure federal

funding. The apprenticeship would be designed to match this non-profit with garment and small product manufacturing companies in the area. Greater integration into manufacturing in Cleveland will result in a new revenue stream while connecting residents to needed employment.

Open Threads is positioned well for this move because it currently owns twenty-five industrial sewing machines and has a solid history of training clients. As part of their education, the students produce items made exclusively of recycled materials that fulfill contracts Open Threads has obtained. While visiting, I was able to view attractive tote bags that had recently been designed and produced.

Another innovation is the provision of sewing classes for individuals who wish to sew for their own families. Begun in April 2025, these community sewing classes are offered at a very reasonable price. Yet another goal is the restructuring of the board to identify new members who have a deep interest in connecting resources to programs, and/or experience in organizational structure and growth. Kerem's strong belief in giving back was instilled in him by his parents. He shared, "I learned from them that one who has been blessed is called to give back by helping others." I left Open Threads with confidence that the spirit of St. Angela is guiding him as he shepherds this ministry into the future. The colorful threads of love and deep respect that Sr. Mary Eileen wove into this ministry from the start are shining brightly!

A WONDERFUL PRZYGODA

“On the seventh day, God . . . rested” (Gen 2:2) and gave us the Sabbath—and, by extension, the sabbatical. I happily shared God’s creative rest during 2024-25, when I spent a sabbatical year teaching with the Ursuline Sisters of the Roman Union in Poland and the Czech Republic. I learned only a little Polish but enough to say that it was a great blessing and a wonderful *przygoda*, a grand adventure.

The Sisters in Poznań, a city a little bigger than Cleveland in northern Poland, welcomed me warmly to their convent and school. Under Sister Jadwiga, the director, and Ania Dorożalska, head of the English department, I taught classes for high school students and weekly after-school lessons for grades 7 and 8. They were glad to have a native speaker, and I was glad to have a chance to work with such dedicated teachers, now colleague-friends.

The Sisters made sure to show me more of Poland. First, a pilgrimage with the senior class to Częstochowa, one of the holiest sites in the country, on October 21, the feast of St. Ursula. Next, in December, a trip to Wrocław, where the

convent dates to the Poor Clares of the thirteenth-century. Best of all, my sister Virginia came to spend Christmas with us, so we got to see this historic city together. Then there was Kraków, home to Wawel Castle and Cathedral, where St. John Paul II celebrated his first Mass. For those who remember the Newbery Award book *The Trumpeter of Krakow*, the tower of St. Mary’s Church still rings with a live trumpet every hour. And, not to be forgotten, Toruń, home to Nicholas Copernicus and gingerbread capital of Poland.

The warmth of the Sisters and students made it difficult to leave Poznań, but I found a new home with the Czech Sisters for April and May, first at their school in Olomouc, a beautiful old university town, and then in the capital, Prague. Again I taught English in middle and high school and there, with the students, prepared for the election that gave us our first American-born Pope. The Czech Republic also brought the opportunity for short pilgrimages to Svatý Hostýn, Velehrad, and, of course, the Carmelite church that houses the miraculous statue of the Infant of Prague.

January 2025, midway through my sabbatical, began the Jubilee Year and the 175th anniversary of the Ursuline Sisters of Cleveland, sparking celebrations of our Church and community. For me it was, as a favorite Polish Christmas carol says, a year of wonders and miracles—*cuda, cuda*—from start to finish.

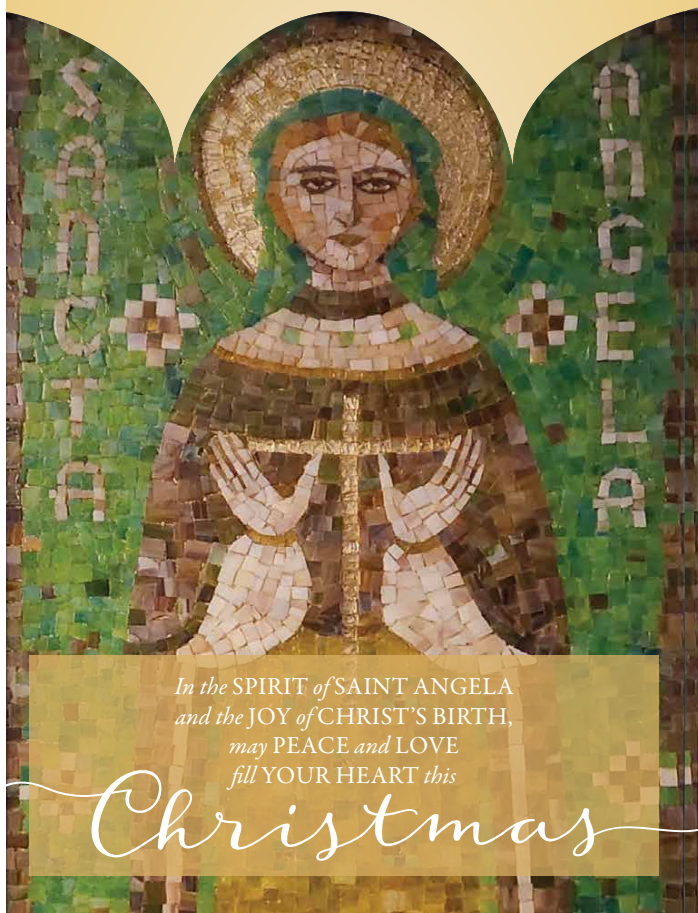
